Gambia in Lockdown – Sunrise closed

On 18th March the Government of The Gambia ordered that all schools should be temporarily closed as part of the Covid19 lockdown arrangements, also present throughout much of the world. The airport was also closed later ending tourism for 2019/20, with tourists going home either earlier than expected or when repatriation flights were available.

The lockdown was extended again on 1st July. This is a difficult time for local people since there is limited government support for people not earning money.



The Trustees have therefore decided to fund the salaries for all 32 staff from our reserves up until now but since 30% of the costs of Sunrise come from school fees, for those that can afford them, we can't do this for very long and if Term 3 of 2019/20 doesn't bring in any fees then reserves will be getting low.

Goodbye to Helen - The end of an Era

AGM 2020 – 5th Sep 2020 near Newport (Wales)


